

## RANKIN'S ROLES

In the early years, only the play is given where no playbill or review can confirm the role that Rankin played. Similarly I do not repeat play, place and theatre if he remained in the same theatre. When a play is repeated, Rankin's role is assumed to be repeated; only occasionally to avoid confusion do I list his role again. This list, of course, is not complete, despite all my efforts to fill the few gaps in his itinerary; for instance, reference by Rankin to his Canuck-like role in "The First Night", a three-act farce, in Chicago a few years before he produced "The Canuck" (Sept 1871) could not be verified. The usefulness of the list is (1) to show Rankin's development, (2) the kind of play done in the period, (3) Rankin's great versatility, energy, and imagination, especially after the mid-seventies when he also directed most of the plays in which he was acting and (4) the acting duties required of an actor in the early stock companies as contrasted to those in the combination companies and under the increasing commercial pressures of later periods.

[Colonel Rankin removes Arthur McKee from the stage and arranges for him to be employed in the Bureau of Agriculture in Quebec City. Arthur McKee resigns two years later to take a commission in a Union Army regiment, which, before he can join it, is wiped out at the Second Battle of Bull Run. His mother relents and gives her permission for him to be an actor. He travels to Chicago and writes to theatre managers across the country for work. He is hired as a walking gentleman at Wood's Theatre in Cincinnati, Ohio.

[From 1863 through the first half of 1864 just a few of his roles were identified but he doubtless had parts in all the plays, which I list to show the kind of drama in which he gained experience.]

The English Opera arrived at Pike's. Rankin remained in Cincinnati for June probably as a supernumerary with the opera under Nickinson's direction. The opera terminated on June 13, after which Nickinson rehearsed the company in Massaniello, The French Spy and A Midsummer Night's Dream for a month's play at the Duffield Theatre in Nashville, TN, from June 22 to July 20. There is no indication that Rankin went with him to Nashville, but he may have. E.L. Davenport also organized a company to tour in late June and early July and may have included Rankin.
